

Dr. Adrian Jjuuko is a Ugandan human rights lawyer, researcher and activist. He is the founder and Executive Director of Human Rights Awareness and Promotion Forum (HRAPF), an organization that operates a specialized legal aid clinic for LGBTI persons and other marginalized groups, and advocates for legal change in Uganda. He is co-chair of the Legal Committee for the Convening For Equality (CFE) which is currently coordinating the legal efforts to challenge Uganda's Anti-Homosexuality Bill 2023 at the Constitutional Court and the East African Court of Justice, a role that he also played during the nullification of the 2013 version of the Bill. Adrian holds an LLD from the University of Pretoria. His latest book is titled '*Strategic litigation and the struggle for lesbian, gay and bisexual equality in Africa*' (2020).
