He has been a member of three teams that won the Pulitzer Prize, including in 2017 for international reporting about Russia's effort to manipulate the presidential election.

Sanger has written three previous books, including one as a CNAS writer-in-residence: *The Inheritance: The World Obama Confronts and the Challenges to American Power*. He is also the author of *Confront and Conceal: Obama's Secret Wars and Surprising Use of American Power* and *The Perfect Weapon: War, Sabotage and Fear in the Cyber Age*. A contributor to CNN, he also teaches national security policy at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government.
