She has been a member of the Charles Darwin Foundation and, in the private sector, has worked in the real estate, hotel, and renewable energy sectors.

She was named Businesswoman of the Year, appointed Vice President of the Quito Chamber of Commerce, and has served on the boards of Global Compact, Movich Hotels, and AmbInBev National Brewery. She was General Manager of Hotel Le Parc and, until 2022, CEO of Equair.

In the public sector, she served as a member of the Yasuni ITT Negotiating Team and was General Manager of Quito Tourism.

She has an MBA and degrees in Finance and Marketing. She also has extensive training in branding and teamwork and has been a speaker on topics such as markets, entrepreneurship, competitiveness, gender equity, leadership, and sustainable development.
