Henadi Al-Saleh is the chairperson of Agility, a global leader in supply chain services, infrastructure, and innovation with over fifty-four thousand employees and operations on six continents. Henadi is also CEO of Agility Global, a business owner and operator and long-term investor in sector-leading businesses, with a footprint in over seventy countries. Agility Global is listed on the Abu Dhabi Securities Exchange in 2024.

Agility Global owns the world's largest aviation services company, Menzies Aviation; a global fuel logistics business, Tristar; and one of the Middle East and Africa's leading industrial real estate and warehousing platforms, Agility Logistics Parks. Its portfolio of investments includes a 9 percent stake in DSV, a global top three freight forwarder; the \$1.3 billion Reem mega-mall in Abu Dhabi; and a ventures portfolio of emerging technology companies.

Al-Saleh joined Agility Public Warehousing Company KSCP, the controlling shareholder of Agility Global, in 2007, as head of investor relations and financial planning and analysis. She was appointed to Agility's board in 2010 and became Agility's chairperson in 2014.

Al-Saleh has been designated one the most powerful businesswoman in the Middle East by Forbes. She serves on the Global Board of Advisors of the Council of Foreign Relations, the board of Gulf Warehousing Company in Qatar, and as a trustee of the Bayan Bilingual School in Kuwait.
