Jean-Marc Lieberherr Monnet is cofounder of the Jean Monnet Institute, established in 2021 to promote the legacy, vision, and philosophy of action of Jean Monnet. He previously held senior leadership roles in international business, including positions at LVMH and Unilever, and served as managing director of the diamond division at Rio Tinto, where he worked to advance responsible social and environmental practices in the mining sector. In 2015, he founded the Natural Diamond Council and served as its first chief executive officer from 2016 to 2020. He received a master's degree in econometrics from the Institut d'Études Politiques de Paris (Sciences Po) and an MBA from INSEAD.
