Kholood Khair is the founder and director of Confluence Advisory, a 'think and do tank' founded in Khartoum, that works on three priority policy areas: peace and security, economy, and governance. She is currently an inaugural Yale Peace Fellow working on inclusive peace. During Sudan's transitional period, she hosted and co-produced *Spotlight 249*, the country's first English-language political discussion and debate program aimed at young Sudanese. Her nearly two decades of experience span research, aid programming, mediation, and policy work in Sudan and across the Horn of Africa. She has written for numerous international publications, provided analysis for global research and policy institutions, and has briefed the UN Security Council and testified before the U.S. Congress and UK Parliament. Khair holds an MSc in violence, conflict, and development from SOAS, University of London, and an MSc in African studies from the University of Oxford.
