Major General Stephanie Ahern is the U.S. Army's director of strategy, plans, and policy, within headquarters, department of the Army G-3/5/7, Pentagon, having previously completed four years as the Army's director of concepts, futures, and concepts center, Army Futures Command, in Austin, TX. As an Army engineer she served overseas in Germany, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Albania, Kosovo, Afghanistan, and Iraq. As an Army strategist, she taught at the U.S. Military Academy, spending summers in Iraq and at the State Department; was a Council on Foreign Relations fellow at Treasury; served in HQDA G-3/5/7, Arlington National Cemetery, office of the secretary of defense for policy, National Security Council, and for the secretary of the Army; and was an adjunct professor for six years at Georgetown University. She has a BS in engineering management from the U.S. Military Academy, a Master of Strategic Studies from the U.S. Army War College, and a Master and PhD in political science from the University of Notre Dame.
