Maria Freire was president and executive director of the Foundation for the National Institutes of Health until September 2021. Prior to that, she served as president of the Albert and Mary Lasker Foundation, president and CEO of the Global Alliance for TB Drug Development, and director of the Office of Technology Transfer with the National Institutes of Health. She is a director of Alexandria Real Estate Equities, Exelixis, Biogen, Keystone Symposia, and on the business advisory board of IRB Barcelona, and is a member of the National Academy of Medicine. She served on the Science Board of the FDA, WHO Commission on Intellectual Property Rights, Innovation and Public Health, and the UN Secretary General's High-Level Panel on Access to Medicines. She is the recipient of the Arthur Fleming Award, DHHS Secretary Award for Distinguished Service, Bayh-Dole Award and the Stevie Award for Woman of the Year. Freire holds a Ph.D. in biophysics from the University of Virginia and a bachelor's from the Universidad Peruana Cayetano Heredia in Lima, Peru.
