Ryan Kaminski is the LGBTQI+ advisor in the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID)'s inclusive development hub in the bureau for development, democracy, and innovation. Previously, he was the global public policy lead at the World Benchmarking Alliance. Kaminski was also a human rights policy advisor at the United Nations Foundation where he oversaw high-level advocacy, cross-sector partnerships, and campaigns with a focus on LGBTI human rights. Kaminski is a coauthor of the Center for American Progress report *Transforming U.S. Foreign Policy to Ensure Dignity and Rights for LGBTI People* and Council on Foreign Relations (CFR) report *Bolstering the UN Human Rights Council's Effectiveness*. He was previously a research associate at CFR and has consulted for Friends of the Global Fight Against AIDS, Tuberculosis, and Malaria. He is a security fellow with the Truman National Security Project, and former Fulbright Fellow. Kaminski received his BA from the University of Chicago and MIA from Columbia University.
