Delphine Schrank is a Mexico-based award-winning narrative investigative journalist who served most recently as chief correspondent for Thomson Reuters covering Mexico and Central America. A contributing editor to the *Virginia Quarterly Review* and adjunct professor at the New School, she is currently investigating violence and life without meaningful rule of law in Central America. Her first book, *The Rebel of Rangoon; a Tale of Defiance and Deliverance in Burma*, a Kirkus 2015 Best Book of the Year, grew out of following pro-democracy dissidents for four years in Burma/Myanmar, where she was dispatched as the *Washington Post's* underground correspondent. She holds degrees from Oxford and Columbia Universities.
